



FUNDING FOR CURATORIAL INTERNSHIPS – SUMMER 2019 GUIDELINES

The IFPDA Foundation was established by the International Fine Print Dealers Association to inspire and fund educational projects that foster connoisseurship in the field of fine prints for a new generation of collectors, curators, and specialists.

Recognizing the importance of early career exposure to prints, the IFPDA Foundation has developed an annual program to fund summer curatorial internships in museum print collections.

The Foundation's objective is to support programs that provide interns with direct exposure to prints in the collection under the guidance of one or more experienced print specialists. The role of the Foundation is limited to providing \$3,000 to support each internship.

REQUIREMENTS

- The host institution is responsible for setting up and implementing its own program, including the selection and supervision of the intern in accordance with all federal, state and local laws and regulations governing this type of position.
- The program must provide object-based experience under the direct supervision of one or more experienced print specialists.
- The internship should be a minimum of two days (preferably more) per week.
- The breadth of the print collection will be considered as well the scope and depth of any specific projects assigned to the intern.
- Each institution and intern will be required to provide an impact statement at the conclusion of the internship.

SELECTION

Selection of the host institutions will take place in February with notification to follow in early March.
